



GUIDELINES FOR ENTRY INTO BRUNEI DARUSSALAM VIA AIR DURING EARLY ENDEMIC PHASE

(Updated as of 10 May 2022)

1. This document outlines **pre-departure and post-arrival requirements for entry into Brunei Darussalam via air during early endemic phase.**
2. **Inbound travel requirements and procedures for fully vaccinated travellers and unvaccinated travellers** that are outlined in this document are **effective on 6 May 2022.**
3. Inbound travel to Brunei Darussalam is only permitted for **fully vaccinated individuals (APPENDIX I)**. However, Brunei Citizens and Permanent Residents (regardless of vaccination status) are allowed to return to Brunei Darussalam and do not need to show proof of medical exemption for COVID-19.
4. **Any foreign nationals who will arrive in Brunei Darussalam on 6 May 2022 and onwards are permitted to travel to Brunei Darussalam via air without an Entry Travel Pass approval**, provided they meet all requirements stated in these guidelines as well as prevailing regulations that are enforced.
5. **Unvaccinated foreign nationals are not permitted** to travel to Brunei Darussalam. However, entry into Brunei Darussalam may be considered if they have certificate of medical exemption for COVID-19 vaccination in line with Brunei Darussalam's COVID-19 vaccine contraindication.
6. **Any foreign nationals who are required to obtain Entry Visa** for entry into Brunei Darussalam must first obtain **appropriate Visa such as Employment Visa, Dependent Visa, Social Visit Visa, Professional Visit Visa and Business Visa** in accordance with prevailing regulations that are enforced.
7. Passengers are permitted to transit/transfer through Brunei International Airport en-route to their final destination. These **transit/transfer passengers** must:
 - (i). Be fully vaccinated;
 - (ii). Obtain negative result for RT-PCR test taken within 2 days before departure OR a certified negative result for ART taken within 1 day before departure; and
 - (iii). Adhere to any other requirements set by the destination country.

- **For arrival in Brunei Darussalam on 6 May 2022 and onwards**, inbound travellers may refer to revised travel requirements and procedures as outlined in **Section 1-2**.
- **For COVID-19 Recovered Travellers** who have proof of infection not more than 90 days before departure date, traveller may refer to travel requirements and procedures outlined in **Section 3-4**.

INBOUND TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS FOR FULLY VACCINATED TRAVELLERS AND UNVACCINATED TRAVELLERS (Effective Date: 6 May 2022)

1. PRE-DEPARTURE REQUIREMENTS

1.1. Prior to departing for Brunei Darussalam, **ALL travellers** are required to:

- (a) **Be fully vaccinated*** whereby the traveller has completed the full course of COVID-19 vaccination (1 dose for Johnson & Johnson vaccine, 2 doses for all other vaccines).

**Effective 1 November 2022, inbound traveller is only permitted to enter Brunei Darussalam if they have obtained second dose of COVID-19 vaccine not more than 3 months before departure date or have obtained booster dose.*

Note: Travellers who are unvaccinated due to medical reasons must present a certificate of medical exemption for COVID-19 vaccination.

- (b) **Obtain negative result for RT-PCR test taken within 2 days before departure to Brunei Darussalam OR certified ART taken within 1 day before departure to Brunei Darussalam** at a designated health centre recognised by the Government of the country of departure.
- (c) Download and register on the **BruHealth Application**.
- (d) Complete **E-Health Arrival Declaration Form** not more than 24 hours before departure to Brunei Darussalam via www.pmo.gov.bn/travelportal or www.healthinfo.gov.bn/travel
- (e) Make **payment for the post-arrival COVID-19 tests (Appendix II)** and obtain a 'Government of Brunei Darussalam' or 'Ministry of Health' **payment receipt** which states the name and passport number of the traveller. Payment can be made online via E-Health Arrival Declaration Form (www.pmo.gov.bn/travelportal or www.healthinfo.gov.bn/travel).

Note: Post-arrival COVID-19 tests and its payment costs are listed in Appendix II.

1.2. **Civil servants returning to Brunei Darussalam after travelling overseas for Government-sponsored official travel are exempted from being required to pay for any post-arrival COVID-19 tests (Paragraph 1.1(e))**. The traveller must show valid supporting document which states that they are on Government-sponsored official travel.

1.3. **Foreign nationals who will enter Brunei Darussalam for short-visit purpose** in which the duration of stay in Brunei Darussalam is less than 90 days, are required to obtain **Travel Medical Insurance with COVID-19 coverage (minimum coverage of BND\$50,000)** either

from Brunei-based or overseas insurer. The insurance must be valid for the duration of their stay in Brunei Darussalam.

Note: The following travellers are exempted from being required to obtain Travel Medical Insurance with COVID-19 coverage:

- (a) Brunei Citizens and Permanent Residents returning to Brunei Darussalam; and
- (b) Foreign nationals who will be entering Brunei Darussalam for the purpose of long-term visit such as employment, studying or as eligible dependent.

However, foreign nationals entering Brunei Darussalam for the purpose of employment, studying or as eligible dependent must adhere to all requirements in accordance with visa/immigration pass requirements.

- 1.4. Upon check-in at the airport, travellers will be required to present **ALL documents listed in Appendix III (where applicable)** to airline / immigration.

2. POST-ARRIVAL PROCEDURES

2.1. FULLY VACCINATED TRAVELLERS

2.1.1. ALL **fully vaccinated travellers** are required to:

- (a) **Perform ART on Day of Arrival (Day 1), Day 2 and Day 3;** and
- (b) Upload every ART result onto BruHealth Application.

2.1.2. Travellers who tested ART negative **do not need** to undergo self-isolation after arriving in Brunei Darussalam.

2.1.3. Travellers who uploaded negative ART result will be **given “Day Pass” on that particular Day through respective BruHealth Application** which allows them to enter any premises in this country.

2.1.4. Should a traveller be tested positive for COVID-19, they will be required to undergo a period of isolation in compliance with existing health protocols.

2.2. UNVACCINATED TRAVELLERS

2.2.1. ALL **unvaccinated travellers** are required to:

- (a) **Perform ART on Day of Arrival (Day 1)** and upload ART result onto BruHealth Application.
- (b) Serve their **mandatory self-isolation at a suitable accommodation (home residence or hotel).**
- (c) Immediately proceed to their declared accommodation and not leave the accommodation except to **undergo RT-PCR test at swab centres recognised by the Government of Brunei Darussalam (Appendix IV) on Day 3 post-arrival** (Day of arrival is Day 1).
- (d) Proceed to their declared accommodation or designated swab centre via **hotel-provided transportation or private transportation.** Travellers are not allowed to use public transportation before completing mandatory self-isolation.
- (e) Remain within their declared accommodation until **receipt of negative result for their Day 3 post-arrival RT-PCR test.**

Note: Traveller may undergo RT-PCR test on Day 3 at health centres or private health clinics that offer RT-PCR swab test services as listed in Appendix IV.

- 2.2.2. If a traveller does not have Bru-HIMS (Brunei Darussalam Healthcare Information and Management System) number which is needed to undergo post-arrival RT-PCR test in Brunei Darussalam, registration for Bru-HIMS can be done by focal or traveller's sponsor on behalf of the traveller at a Government Health Clinic or Government Hospital in Brunei Darussalam.
- 2.2.3. Should a traveller be tested positive for COVID-19, they will be required to undergo a period of isolation in compliance with existing health protocols.

INBOUND TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS FOR COVID-19 RECOVERED TRAVELLERS

3. PRE-DEPARTURE REQUIREMENTS

- 3.1. **COVID-19 Recovered Travellers** who have proof of infection in which the date of being tested COVID-19 positive does not exceed 90 days before departure date are **exempted from being required to undergo pre-departure RT-PCR test or ART (paragraph 1.1(b))**. However, they are required to adhere to other pre-departure requirements as outlined in **paragraph 1.1**.
- 3.2. COVID-19 Recovered Travellers must show valid proof of infection such as **COVID-19 Recovery Certificate, Laboratory Report or Medical Report from Hospital or Doctor**.
- 3.3. Upon check-in at the airport, COVID-19 recovered travellers will be required to present **ALL documents listed in Appendix III (where applicable) to airline / immigration**.

4. POST-ARRIVAL REQUIREMENTS

- 4.1. **COVID-19 Recovered Travellers** are:
 - (a) **Only required to perform ART on Day of Arrival (Day 1)** and upload ART result onto BruHealth Application; and
 - (b) **Exempted from being required to undergo mandatory self-isolation** after arriving in Brunei Darussalam.

**APPENDIX I
FULLY VACCINATED TRAVELLERS**

- Individuals who have received a COVID-19 vaccine that has been granted WHO Emergency Use Listing.
- Individual has a certificate of proof of vaccination issued by a recognized health jurisdiction (preferably digital vaccination record) or the WHO International Certificate of Vaccination (yellow book). Individuals vaccinated in Brunei Darussalam must show proof of vaccination on the BruHealth App.
- Individual has completed the full course of COVID-19 vaccination (1 dose for Johnson & Johnson vaccine, 2 doses for all other vaccines).
- Individuals below 18 years travelling with a group of all vaccinated adults will follow Vaccinated Traveller protocols.

*Unvaccinated individuals refer to individuals who do not fulfil requirements outlined in APPENDIX I.
