



GUIDELINE FOR EXITING BRUNEI DARUSSALAM VIA AIR DURING EARLY ENDEMIC PHASE

(Updated as of 10 May 2022)

1. This document outlines **revised requirements on outbound travel by air during early endemic phase.**
2. **Any travellers who intend to exit Brunei Darussalam to any destination are no longer required to obtain Exit Approval** from Prime Minister's Office (PMO).
3. **Citizens and residents of Brunei Darussalam*** are permitted to travel out of Brunei Darussalam if they have received:
 - (i). **2 doses of COVID-19 vaccine with the second dose administered not more than 3 months before departure date, OR**
 - (ii). **Booster dose for COVID-19 vaccine**

**Effective 15 May 2022, vaccination requirement for outbound travel is extended to citizens and residents of Brunei Darussalam aged 12 to 17 years.*

Note: Please refer to Appendix I for more information and requirements needed to be fully vaccinated.

4. However, **unvaccinated travellers** may exit Brunei Darussalam if they have certificate of medical exemption* for COVID-19 vaccination.

**Exemptions may be obtained from medical health centers on the basis of medical contraindications, or other reasons such as having recovered from COVID-19 six (6) weeks prior.*

5. Any foreign nationals who are currently residing in Brunei Darussalam under employment pass, visit pass (social, professional and business), student pass, dependent pass and intend to exit the country temporarily and re-enter Brunei Darussalam, therefore they are required to secure **Re-Entry Visa** before intended travel date. This requirement only applies to foreigners whose nationality is required to have a re-entry visa.

EXIT TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS

1. Before exiting Brunei Darussalam, **Brunei Citizens and Permanent Residents** are required to:
 - (a) Complete registration via **e-Register system at Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA) website:** <http://www.mfa.gov.bn/Pages/eRegister.aspx>
 - (b) Obtain **Travel Medical Insurance with COVID-19 coverage (minimum coverage of BND\$50,000)** either from Brunei-based or overseas insurer if travelling for short visit purpose. The insurance must be valid for the duration of their stay in the foreign country.

Note:

The following travellers are exempted from being required to obtain Travel Medical Insurance with COVID-19 coverage:

- (i). Brunei Citizens and Permanent Residents who are travelling overseas for employment, studies as eligible dependant or hold a long term visa/immigration pass in the destination country;
- (ii). Permanent Residents who are traveling to their country of nationality; and
- (iii). Civil servants who are travelling overseas for Government-sponsored official travel (Please refer to paragraph 2).

However, Brunei Citizens and Permanent Residents who are travelling overseas for employment, studying or as eligible dependent must adhere to all requirements in accordance with visa/immigration pass requirements.

2. **Civil servants who are travelling overseas for Government-sponsored official travel are exempted from being required to obtain Travel Medical Insurance with COVID-19 coverage (minimum coverage of BND\$50,000).** The traveller must show valid supporting document which states that they are on Government-sponsored official travel.
3. **Students (Brunei Citizens and Permanent Residents) who will begin their studies overseas or will be returning to the country of studies** must complete online registration forms via the following links before exiting Brunei Darussalam:
 - (a) Registration Form for returning to country of studies: bit.ly/pendaftarankeluarnegeri
 - (b) Registration Form for Private Student: bit.ly/pendaftaranprivatestudent
4. It is the **travellers' responsibility to fulfil any other requirements as required by the destination country.**
5. **Should destination countries require travellers to undergo RT-PCR test or ART before departure,** traveller may undergo RT-PCR test at health center or private health clinic that provides services for RT-PCR test or ART at certified ART centers as listed in **Appendix II.**
6. Upon check-in at the airport / arrival at the airport, the traveller will be required to present **ALL documents listed in Appendix III (where applicable) to airlines / immigration.**
7. Travellers will need to comply with **all inbound requirements and health protocols** upon their return to Brunei Darussalam.

**APPENDIX I
FULLY VACCINATED INDIVIDUALS**

- Individuals who have received a COVID-19 vaccine that has been granted WHO Emergency Use Listing.
- Individual has a certificate of proof of vaccination issued by a recognized health jurisdiction (preferably digital vaccination record) or the WHO International Certificate of Vaccination (yellow book). Individuals vaccinated in Brunei Darussalam must show proof of vaccination on the BruHealth App.
- Individual has completed the full course of COVID-19 vaccination as required for outbound travel (**Have obtained second dose of COVID-19 vaccination not more than 3 months before departure date, or have received booster dose**).
- Individuals below 12 years travelling with a group of all vaccinated adults will follow Vaccinated Traveller protocols.

*Unvaccinated individuals refer to individuals who do not fulfil requirements outlined in APPENDIX I.
