# GUIDELINES FOR BUSINESS PREMISES IN THE EARLY ENDEMIC PHASE UNDER THE NATIONAL COVID-19 RECOVERY FRAMEWORK

- 1. This document provides updated guidelines for business premises during the Early Endemic Phase of the National COVID-19 Recovery Framework.
- 2. The Early Endemic Phase began on 15 December 2021 and among the measures that can be implemented include updates to the opening and easing of restrictions in workplaces and business premises for vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals. The Endemic phase accepts the 'new normal' of living in a post-pandemic COVID-19 world with minimal disruption.
- 3. The Early Endemic Phase approach will continue compliance with the COVID-19 Control Measures and expand the use of Antigen Rapid Test (ART) as a screening and surveillance tool to detect the possibility of early infection.
- 4. The COVID-19 Control Measures are as follows:
  - a) Use of BruHealth App
    - BruHealth Registration : All premises must register for a BruHealth QR code that is printed and placed at the entrance area.
    - Employees registration : Owners are required to ensure all their employees are registered in the BruHealth App. The employees are

- : Premise owners must ensure that all individuals entering the premise scan their BruHealth App upon entry (including all employees / staff / volunteers).

- BruHealth Code Colour
- : Premise owners must ensure that only individuals with BruHealth green and yellow codes are allowed to enter.
- b) Complete Vaccination
- Premise owners must ensure that all employees / staff / volunteers who are eligible to be vaccinated (no medical contraindications) have been fully vaccinated. An individual is considered to have been fully vaccinated if he or she has received **two doses** of the vaccine in the World Health Organization (WHO) Emergency Use List or a vaccine approved by the Brunei Darussalam Medicines Control Authority (BDMCA). Vaccination status in the BruHealth app, International Vaccination Certificate or Prophylaxis Book (Yellow Book) or other acceptable vaccination record can be

shown to the company management or event organizer as proof of vaccination.

- c) Social distancing
- Adopt social and physical distancing measures of at least 1.5 metres between individuals if possible.
- d) Premise Ventilation
- Owners must ensure adequate ventilation of their premises.
- e) Business Continuity Protocols
- Have a Business Continuity Plan (BCP) in place to ensure buiness remains operational during an outbreak such as having alternate teams and contact tracing guidelines.
- f) Antigen Rapid Test (ART)
- Implement ART, when necessary, according to the ART Guidelines issued by the Ministry of Health (MOH).
- 5. Business premises are required to provide their full cooperation and comply with any directives issued by the Government from time to time. Any business premise owner found not in compliance with the guidelines for re-opening of business premises may be subject to legal action under the Infectious Diseases Act Chapter 204 and the premises may be ordered to close immediately.
- 6. The updated guidelines for opening of business premises or current business operations including activities permitted are as follows:

#### A. GUIDELINES FOR DINE-IN SERVICES AT FOOD PREMISES

Updated measures and requirements for dine-in services at food premises such as restaurants, cafes, stalls and food courts are as follows:

# B. GUIDELINES FOR FOOD CATERING SERVICES AT BANQUET HALLS/PRIVATE RESIDENCES

Updated measures and requirements for food catering services at banquet halls/private residences will refer to the Guidelines on Mass Gathering.

### C. GUIDELINES FOR CINEMAS

Updated measures and requirements for cinemas are as follows:

## **G. GUIDELINES FOR OPEN AIR STALLS AND MARKETS**

Updates to the measures and requirements for open air stalls and markets are as follows:

- Vaccinated and unvaccinated employees with GREEN and YELLOW BruHealth colour codes are allowed to work.
- Employees are permitted to work in all areas of the premises and recommended to undergo ART at least once a week and receive a negative ART result.
- Owner is encouraged to carry out regular ART testing on all employees in line with the ART Guidelines issued by the Ministry of Health.
- Any employee that is not feeling well is advised not to come to work.
- Face masks are no longer required to be worn when outdoors, except in crowded places or during outdoor mass gatherings.
- Premises must register for a BruHealth QR code that is printed and placed at the entrance area.
- Allowed to open at maximum capacity of the premises at any one time or maximum capacity of 300 people (whichever is lower).
- Ensure social distancing measures are in place.
- Perform body temperature checks before entering the premise and provide hand sanitisers.
- Adhere to guidelines on cleaning and sanitisation of premises.

#### Customers

- Scan QR code using the BruHealth app. Vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals (including children under the age of 18) with GREEN and YELLOW BruHealth colour codes are allowed to enter the premises.
- Both vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals (including children under the age of 12) are allowed to enter with social distancing measures in place.
- Face masks are no longer required to be worn when outdoors, except in crowded places or during outdoor mass gatherings.
- Individuals who are not feeling well are advised not to enter the premises.
- Practice personal hygiene at all times such as washing hands regularly or using hand sanitiser.

#### H. GUIDELINES FOR SUPERMARKETS AND RETAIL SHOPS

Updates to operational measures and requirements in supermarkets and retail shops are as follows:

- Vaccinated and unvaccinated employees with **GREEN** and **YELLOW** BruHealth colour codes are allowed to work.
- Employees are permitted to work in all areas of the premises and recommended to undergo ART at least once a week and receive a negative ART result.
- Owner is encouraged to carry out regular ART testing on all employees in line with the ART Guidelines issued by the Ministry of Health.
- Any employee that is not feeling well is advised not to come to work.
- Employees are required to wear face masks at all times.
- Premises must register for a BruHealth QR code that is printed and placed at the entrance area.
- Allowed to open at maximum capacity of the premises at any one time or maximum capacity of 300 people (whichever is lower).
- Ensure social distancing measures are in place.
- Perform body temperature checks before entering the premise and provide hand sanitisers.
- Adhere to guidelines on cleaning and sanitisation of premises.

#### Customers

- Scan QR code using the BruHealth app. Vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals (including children under the age of 18) with GREEN and YELLOW BruHealth colour codes are allowed to enter the premises.
- Individuals who are not feeling well are advised not to enter the premises.
- Face mask is required at all times.
- Practice social distancing and personal hygiene at all times such as washing hands regularly or using hand sanitiser.

# I. GUIDELINES FOR PRIVATE BUSINESS OFFICES, MANUFACTURING AND PROCESSING COMPANIES

Updates to operational measures and requirements for private business offices, manufacturing and processing companies are as follows:

- Vaccinated and unvaccinated employees with GREEN and YELLOW BruHealth colour codes are allowed to work.
- Employees are permitted to work in all areas of the premises and recommended to undergo ART at least once a week and receive a negative ART result.
- Owner is encouraged to carry out regular ART testing on all employees in line with the ART Guidelines issued by the Ministry of Health.
- Any employee that is not feeling well is advised not to come to work.
- Employees are required to wear face masks at all times.
- Premises must register for a BruHealth QR code that is printed and placed at the entrance area.
- Allowed to open at maximum office capacity with social distancing measures in place.
- Perform body temperature checks before entering the premise and provide hand sanitisers.
- Adhere to guidelines on cleaning and sanitisation of premises.

#### Customers

- Scan QR code using the BruHealth app. Vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals (including children under the age of 18) with GREEN and YELLOW BruHealth colour codes are allowed to enter the premises.
- Individuals who are not feeling well are advised not to enter the premises.
- Face mask is required at all times.
- Practice social distancing and personal hygiene at all times such as washing hands regularly or using hand sanitiser.

#### J. GUIDELINES FOR HOTELS AND OTHER LODGINGS

Updated measures and requirements for hotels and other lodgings that includes common facilities such as swimming pools, sports facilities and cafes and restaurants on the premises shall refer to relevant guidelines such as the Guidelines for Indoor Playgrounds, Guidelines for Recreational Activities in Indoor Sports Facilities, Guidelines for Recreational Activities in Outdoor Facilities and Guidelines for Dine-In Services at Food Premises.

#### K. GUIDELINES FOR PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

Updates to operational measures and requirements for public transportation such as buses, taxis, e-hailing, water taxi, passenger boat and passenger ship are as follows:

#### K1. Buses, taxis and e-Hailing

#### **Owners/Employees**

- Vaccinated and unvaccinated employees with **GREEN** and **YELLOW** BruHealth colour codes are allowed to work.
- Employees are recommended to undergo ART at least once a week and receive a negative ART result.
- Owner is encouraged to carry out regular ART testing on all employees in line with the ART Guidelines issued by the Ministry of Health.
- Any employee that is not feeling well is advised not to work.
- Employees are required to wear face masks at all times.
- Owners must register for a BruHealth QR code that is printed and placed at the entrance of vehicle.
- Number of passengers allowed for buses, taxis and e-Hailing is limited to 75% passenger capacity (excluding the driver) with social distancing measures in place.
- For taxis and e-Hailing, the vehicle seat capacity and maximum passengers (excluding the driver's seat) are as follows:

- Premises must register for a BruHealth QR code that is printed and placed at the entrance area.
- Allowed to open at maximum capacity of the premises at any one time or maximum capacity of 300 people (whichever is lower).
- Ensure social distancing measures are in place.
- Use of the facility is not limited.
- Open to registered and unregistered members.
- Single, double or pair sports and noncontact artistic sports are allowed. Team sports not exceeding 15 people are only allowed for training. Exchange or mixing of players is permitted.
