

PLANNING THE TRIP

Ensure you are fully vaccinated

- Completed full course of vaccination for COVID-19 vaccine that has been granted WHO **Emergency Use Listing.**
- Two-dose regimen: Individual is at least 14 days post-second dose of the vaccine.
- One-dose regimen: Individual is at least 28 days post-vaccination.



Remain in any Green list country/region for the past 14 days prior to departure



BEFORE DEPARTURE:

Take pre-departure COVID-19 tests

• Take RT-PCR test within 48 hours prior to departure at a designated medical centre.

INBOUND TRAVEL FOR UNVACCINATED TRAVELLERS

TRAVEL PURPOSE: ESSENTIAL TRAVEL ONLY.

Unvaccinated Brunei citizens and permanent residents may return to Brunei Darussalam.

Unvaccinated foreign nationals are NOT permitted to travel to Brunei Darussalam. However, those with medical exemption may be considered for entry into Brunei Darussalam.




