

HOW TO ENTER BRUNEI DARUSSALAM VIA AIR?

Procedures will take into effect from 1 Jan 2022



INBOUND TRAVEL FROM GREEN-LIST COUNTRIES/REGION

TRAVEL PURPOSE: NON-ESSENTIAL TRAVEL ALLOWED.

PLANNING THE TRIP

1

Ensure you are fully vaccinated

- Completed full course of vaccination for COVID-19 vaccine that has been granted WHO Emergency Use Listing.
- Two-dose regimen: Individual is at least 14 days post-second dose of the vaccine.
- One-dose regimen: Individual is at least 28 days post-vaccination.



2

Remain in any Green list country/region for the past 14 days prior to departure

BEFORE DEPARTURE:

3

Take pre-departure COVID-19 tests

- Take RT-PCR test within 48 hours prior to departure at a designated medical centre.



4

Make payment for the post-arrival RT-PCR Test & ART Test

- Payment can be made online via this link: <https://www.healthinfo.gov.bn/entry-payment/#/user/login>

5

Download and register on the BruHealth App

6

Purchase Travel Medical Insurance with COVID-19 coverage (minimum coverage of BND50,000) either from Brunei-based or overseas insurer

- Required only for Foreign Nationals entering Brunei Darussalam for short visit purpose (less than 90 days stay in Brunei Darussalam).

Submit Arrival Declaration on PMO Travel Portal (<http://www.pmo.gov.bn/travelportal>)

8

Prepare documents to be presented to airline/immigration authorities:

- ✓ Vaccination record indicating full vaccination for COVID-19.
- ✓ Valid Traveller's Passport.
- ✓ Arrival Declaration.
- ✓ Negative Pre-departure RT-PCR Test 48 hours before departure.
- ✓ Receipt for post-arrival RT-PCR test and ART.
- ✓ Certificate of Travel Medical Insurance with COVID-19 coverage (minimum coverage of BND50,000).
- ✓ Valid visa / immigration pass (for nationalities that require it).



ARRIVAL

Undergo both RT-PCR test and ART at Brunei International Airport



10

Serve mandatory self-isolation at declared hotel accommodation until receipt of negative arrival RT-PCR test



11

Undergo additional Day-3 ART test at any designated ART centre at traveller's own cost.

INBOUND TRAVEL FROM NON GREEN-LIST COUNTRIES/REGION

TRAVEL PURPOSE: ESSENTIAL TRAVEL ONLY.

PLANNING THE TRIP

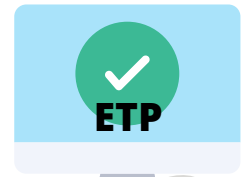
1 Ensure you are fully vaccinated

- Completed full course of vaccination for COVID-19 vaccine that has been granted WHO Emergency Use Listing.
- For a two-dose regimen, the individual is at least 14 days post-second dose of the vaccine.
- For a one-dose regimen, the individual is at least 28 days post-vaccination.



2 ★ Apply for Entry Travel Pass (ETP) on PMO Travel Portal (<http://www.pmo.gov.bn/travelportal>)

- Only applicable for Foreign Nationals (Returning Brunei citizens and permanent residents are exempted).



BEFORE DEPARTURE:

3 Take pre-departure COVID-19 tests

- Take RT-PCR test within 48 hours prior to departure at a designated medical centre.



4 Make payment for the post-arrival RT-PCR Test & ART Test

- Payment can be made online via this link: <https://www.healthinfo.gov.bn/entry-payment/#/user/login>

5 Download and register on the BruHealth App

6 Purchase Travel Medical Insurance with COVID-19 coverage (minimum coverage of BND50,000) either from Brunei-based or overseas insurer

- Only applicable to Foreign Nationals entering Brunei Darussalam for short visit purpose (less than 90 days stay in Brunei Darussalam).



7 Submit Arrival Declaration on PMO Travel Portal (<http://www.pmo.gov.bn/travelportal>)

Prepare documents to be presented to airline/immigration authorities:

- ✓ Vaccination record indicating full vaccination for COVID-19.
- ✓ Valid Traveller's passport.
- ✓ Entry Travel Pass (for foreign nationals).
- ✓ Arrival Declaration.
- ✓ Negative Pre-departure RT-PCR Test 48 hours before departure.
- ✓ Receipt for post-arrival RT-PCR test and ART.
- ✓ Certificate of Travel Medical Insurance with COVID-19 coverage (minimum coverage of BND50,000).
- ✓ Valid visa / immigration pass (for nationalities that require it).

9 Undergo ART at Brunei International Airport

10 Serve mandatory self-isolation at declared hotel accommodation until receipt of negative arrival RT-PCR test

Undergo RT-PCR test at swab centre on Day-5 post-arrival



★ Individuals below 18 years travelling with a group of all vaccinated adults will follow Vaccinated Traveller Protocols.

HOW TO ENTER BRUNEI DARUSSALAM VIA AIR?

Procedures will take into effect from 1 Jan 2022



INBOUND TRAVEL FOR UNVACCINATED TRAVELLERS

TRAVEL PURPOSE: ESSENTIAL TRAVEL ONLY.

Unvaccinated Brunei citizens and permanent residents may return to Brunei Darussalam .

Unvaccinated foreign nationals are NOT permitted to travel to Brunei Darussalam. However, those with medical exemption may be considered for entry into Brunei Darussalam.

PLANNING THE TRIP

1

- ★ Apply for Entry Travel Pass on PMO Travel Portal (<http://www.pmo.gov.bn/travelportal>)
 - Only applicable for unvaccinated Foreign Nationals with medical exemption (Returning Brunei citizens and permanent residents are exempted).



BEFORE DEPARTURE:

2

- Take pre-departure COVID-19 tests
 - Take RT-PCR test within 48 hours prior to departure at a designated medical centre.

- Make payment for the post-arrival RT-PCR Test & ART Test
 - Payment can be made online via this link: <https://www.healthinfo.gov.bn/entry-payment/#/user/login>

- Download and register on the BruHealth App

5

- Purchase Travel Medical Insurance with COVID-19 coverage (minimum coverage of BND50,000) either from Brunei-based or overseas insurer
 - Only applicable to Foreign Nationals entering Brunei Darussalam for short visit purpose (less than 90 days stay in Brunei Darussalam).



6

- Submit Arrival Declaration on PMO Travel Portal (<http://www.pmo.gov.bn/travelportal>)

Prepare documents to be presented to airline/immigration authorities:

- ✔ Valid Traveller's Passport.
- ✔ Entry Travel Pass (for foreign nationals only).
- ✔ Arrival Declaration.
- ✔ Hotel Reservation in Brunei Darussalam for self-isolation purpose.
- ✔ Negative Pre-departure RT-PCR Test 48 hours before departure.
- ✔ Receipt for post-arrival RT-PCR test and ART.
- ✔ Certificate of Travel Medical Insurance with COVID-19 coverage (minimum coverage of BND50,000).
- ✔ Valid visa / immigration pass (for nationalities that require it).



ARRIVAL

8

- Undergo ART at Brunei International Airport

9

- Serve ten (10) days mandatory self-isolation at declared hotel accommodation in Brunei Darussalam

Undergo RT-PCR test at swab centre on Day-8 post-arrival





